




MALCOLM MCKEON YACHT DESIGN

Phis 50m is the first design from new super-catamaran brand BlackCat, founded by Australian yachtsman Mitch Booth with design by Malcolm McKeon. The sleek, low-drag carbon fibre design is aimed at high performance cruising, reaching 30 knots with ease and accessing shallow anchorages thanks to a low draught. The massive main deck offers a spectacular and stable entertainment platform thanks to the hull's low pitch and roll. blackcat-superyachts.com

PASTROVICH STUDIO

A layout that enhances onboard life is at the centre of Pastrovich's 80m X-Prime concept. The whole-deck owner's apartment has panoramic views, a balcony and is divided into carefully considered relaxing, working and eating areas that feel connected. A grand beach club has openings to port and starboard as well as a "glasshouse" for shelter with a view, while the exterior design sticks to simple, sweeping lines. pastrovich.com

FACHERIS DESIGN

Florida-based Patrizio Facheris, former chief designer at Michael Peters, describes his Aqueous 120m as a "subtle accord between generous dimensions and a fresh profile". It uses lots of glass for natural light, while outdoor spaces include a 400m² aft deck with large infinity pool and a foredeck spa pool with a sunpad that converts into a helipad. A hybrid propulsion system is envisioned, for reduced emissions. facherisdesign.com
